LANE AND INTERSECTION CLOSURE SCHEDULED AT NEWTOWN ROAD AND ELAM AVENUE FOR UTILITY WORK

NORFOLK – Motorists are advised that [HRSD](https://www.hrsd.com) crews will be performing sanitary sewer pipeline improvements at the intersection of Newtown Road and Elam Avenue that requires lane and intersection closures. During this work, traffic will follow a signed detour using Coliss Avenue and Fair Meadows Road as indicated on the map below. The detour is scheduled to begin as early as March 3 and is expected to remain in place for 2 to 3 weeks.
